HIV/HBV or HIV/HCV coinfection

This trial is **enrolling now**. Depending on eligibility and available places in your area, you may be able to enrol in this trial.

About this trial

This study is looking at how our immune system functions when we are coinfecting with both HIV and either hepatitis B or C.

It might show us how some people can clear hepatitis from their system when they're on treatment while others can when they're not.

What is this trial studying?

How many participants will this trial enrol?

How long is this trial planned to go for?

Participants in this trial will be asked to follow the trial protocol for 6 months.

You *may* be eligible to participate in this trial if you meet the following criteria:

- At least 18 years old
- HIV-positive
- Have active hepatitis B or C

You *will not* be eligible to participate in this trial if you meet any of the following criteria:
